The Swakane Wildlife Area is an 11,000± acre land area preserving winter habitat for mule deer. Upland game birds including chukar, partridge, grouse and quail use the area. Tamarack Creek runs through the northwest corner of the tract. The property is stocked with 502± MBF of primarily Douglas-fir and ponderosa pine.
